JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The Port of Poulsbo is currently accepting resumes or applications for a full-time, Maintenance Worker 1 position.

In general, the Maintenance Worker 1 position is responsible for being familiar with all areas of maintenance within the Port of Poulsbo, and shall have at least two (2) years of experience as a maintenance technician. Repairing, maintaining and upgrading docks, floats, piers, water systems, fire systems, and electrical systems are just a few of the tasks performed by this position.

REQUIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- High school equivalency
- Current Washington State Drivers license
- Current First Aid & CPR
- 24 hour HAZWOPER training

DAILY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Repairing, maintaining and upgrading Port infrastructure, including, but not limited to:
 - Docks, floats, piers, breakwater, water systems, fire systems, and electrical systems.
- Cleaning restroom and laundry facilities.
- Landscaping and beautification of Port facilities, including but not limited to:
 - Weed pulling, shrub and tree trimming, pressure washing, trash clean-up, etc.
- Being familiar with, and in compliance with, the Port's Fuel Dock Procedures and Guidelines.
- Being familiar with the Port's Emergency Response Plan, and the Emergency Response Team contact list.
- Being proficient with the deployment of fuel spill containment materials.
- Being familiar with, and in compliance with, the Port's Accident Prevention Program.
- Provide assistance and training to those workers less experienced or qualified.
- Other tasks as assigned by the Maintenance Manager.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- May be required to join the Port's CENCOM emergency response call list.

This employee must be capable of performing these duties with no more than normal supervision, and demonstrate his or her dependability and reliability on the job. A neat, clean appearance and a pleasant attitude are a must.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, have a valid WA State driver's license and be capable of performing the duties listed above.
